

EVANGEL-ISTIC

INTRODUCTION-- Introduce yourself/ask their name. If any obvious connections, ask about that.

- Brothers--Sports Teams/Bands/Surfing
- Sisters--"I like your scarf"
- Are you a student here? What year? Major?

SPIRITUAL--Shift the conversation to a spiritual matter while keeping things open for conversation!

- Are you a spiritual guy/girl?
- What do you think about Jesus?
- What do you think about God?

TESTIMONY--Share a bit about you--Sin, Bible, Repentance, refreshment.

- "Elevator Testimony" or "90 second" testimony
- Have a 10 sec, 30 sec, minute, 90 sec testimony
- No "Kingdom Lingo"--ex. Dtime, Quiet Time, Share
- Be willing to highlight your sin
- Emphasize how awesome life is with Jesus.
- Explain how all that comes from the Bible.

INVITE--Gauge the interest. Invite to Bible Talk, try to set up study.

- Specifically ask to study the Bible
- Time, Place, mention other people.
- See how soon, push a little bit.
- No surprises!

CONTACT--get their contact info

- Phone
- Email
- Always be ready to follow up and soon

OTHER THINGS TO CONSIDER:

- Pull out your Bible--Ask "What do you think about this scripture?"
- Religious--Its ok to challenge a bit, but don't "interrogate"
- Don't waste time with philosophical debates--they go nowhere and frustrate you. Gal 6:7-9--Don't be deceived God cannot be mocked. God doesn't lose when an atheist isn't open.
- Go with people
